The Justice Initiative will be using Canvas to archive materials related to our programming. You should have already received an email inviting you to join our Canvas class. That email will contain the email address that you should create your Canvas account under and a “Get Started” button that you can use to create a Canvas account.

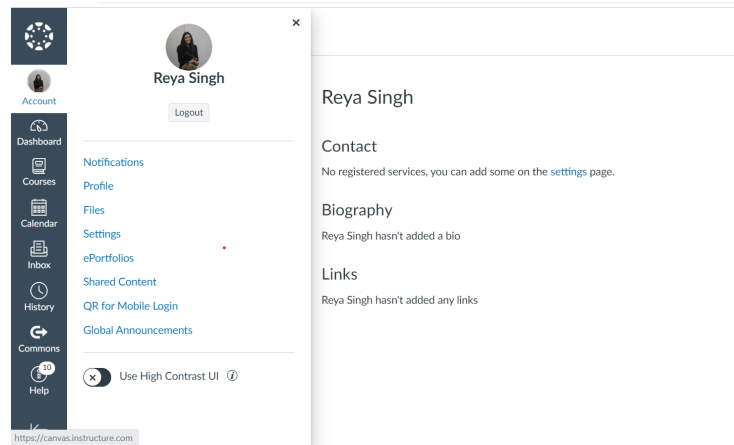
Click on the “Get Started” button and sign up as a student. You will be prompted to put in a join code and create a username and password. Once you input this information, you should be able to view the Justice Initiative Canvas page.

Some **profile names** were distorted by Canvas into a series of numbers. If that’s true for you, you can change your profile name as described in instructions below.

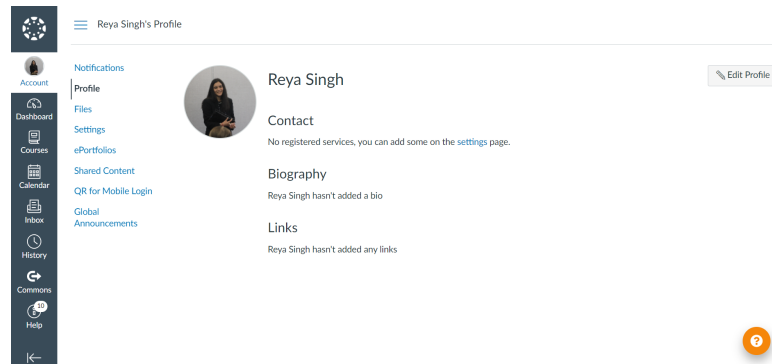
